## A Very Successful Mobile Spay/Neuter Clinic – Kudos to Port Vue!

Our September mobile spay/neuter clinic held in Port Vue was a fantastic success!

Here's a report from our cat coordinator, Christie Yasofsky:

Wow, what a weekend! We were very successful! We were able to trap 31 cats from the community as well as rescue 7 kittens under 5 weeks old. Out of the 31 cats/kittens trapped we took 19 into rescue therefore only releasing 12 community cats back into the borough. The support from the borough was overwhelming! The mayor was exceptionally supportive, the police department was wonderful in watching over us as we trapped the night before, and the council's support for this project sets a standard I wish all communities would follow. We met many wonderful community members during this project and truly enjoyed our time in Port Vue. WTAE ran a story about this project and hopefully it will pave the way for many communities in the future. We sincerely thank Port Vue for allowing us to come into their community and helping these animals. It speaks volumes of the character of the citizens of Port Vue and how truly supportive your people are.

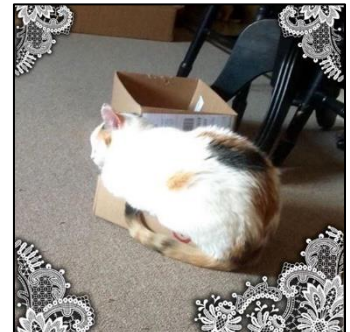
